

# Frequently Asked Questions

## How does part time scheduling work?

Parents have the choice of full time or part time scheduling. Full time is M-F 8AM—230PM. Part time is any combination of full and half days as designated by the parents. Half days run from 8AM—11:30 AM.

## Is there an after school program?

Yes, Extended Day program is available until 6PM every day.

## Do pre-k students participate in school functions?

Yes, pre-k children will have art, gym, and religion class weekly and have lunch and recess with grades K-4 when they are ready. Pre-k children will also go to mass monthly with their Prayer Partners and the rest of the school.

## Can pre-k students ride the bus?

Only Hamilton Twp. Pre-k students are permitted to travel on the bus. EHT currently does not bus students until kindergarten. Therefore, they must be picked up and dropped off by parents.

## What is the pre-k uniform?

Sweatpants/sweat shorts and sweatshirt/t-shirt available for ordering through the school.

## What is the age requirement for pre-k students?

All students must be at least 3 1/2 years old by September 30th.

## Logical and Mathematical

Counting to 20, recognizing and writing numbers 0-10, sorting, classifying, matching, making patterns, naming and drawing shapes, position words, size comparisons, measuring with non-standard units of measure, sequencing, recognizing colors, and calendar skills.

## Social and Interpersonal

Listening skills, taking turns, following directions, task completion, and solving problems with words.
